



Guidance of how to complete an IUU Notification

Consignment

A. Reference

The reference number is read-only and is automatically completed upon the successful submission of the document.

B. BCP

The Border Control Post (BCP) refers to the list of ports maintained by the UK Government that are able to receive and handle certain imports. The entries in the list shown on the form consist of Port Health Authorities that have signed up to use PHILIS.

1. Company accepting charges for the consignment

Start typing the name of the organisation into the Search box. If any matching organisations are found, they will be shown in a list which can be selected from. If the organisation does not appear in the list, click on the 'New' button to add the organisation into the database. Any organisations added will be only added to the address book of the organisation currently logged in to the system.

2. Company responsible for the consignment

Start typing the name of the organisation into the Search box. If any matching organisations are found, they will be shown in a list which can be selected from. If the organisation does not appear in the list, click on the 'New' button to add the organisation into the database. Any organisations added will be only added to the address book of the organisation currently logged in to the system.

3. Importer

Start typing the name of the organisation into the Search box. If any matching organisations are found, they will be shown in a list which can be selected from. If the organisation does not appear in the list, click on the 'New' button to add the organisation into the database. Any organisations added will be only added to the

address book of the organisation currently logged in to the system.

4. Date of declaration

Enter the date of declaration in the format of DD/MM/YYYY.

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The Species box is enabled for automated searching. By entering the start of the name of the species into this box, a list will show below of any matching species.

The up and down cursor keys will move the pink selection bar up and down. Pressing either the enter / return key or the tab key will accept the selected species and add it to the Species box. Alternatively, clicking on the species name with a mouse button will select the species.

To add multiple species, place a comma (,) on the end of the text and start typing in the new species name and select a new species from the list.

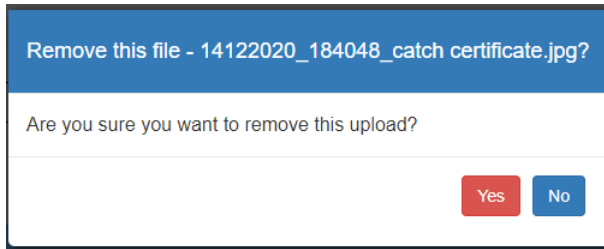

Click on the 'Save' button to store the notification details.

Submitting the notification

Once the notification has been saved, a Submit button will appear next to the Save button. If all of the validation checks have passed a reference number for the notification will be generated and will appear in box A on the screen.

If the submit was successful, a 'Print' button will be shown which, when clicked, will open a PDF version of the declaration that needs to be printed off and sent to the offices of the selected BCP. The declaration should be signed and stamped by the signatory completing the notification.

The notification needs to be accompanied by any original catch certification relevant to the consignment:

Direct imports - If the consignment has been exported by the flag state issuing the Catch Certificate, we will still require submission of the original Catch Certificate.

Indirect imports - If the consignment has been exported by a third country other than the flag state, we will require submission of the original processing statement issued by the exporting country only. All copies of Catch Certificates for these imports can be submitted electronically through DES.
